Industry News Cyber Security

What is Cyber Security?

Cybersecurity is the state or process of protecting and recovering computer systems, networks, devices, and programs from any type of cyberattack. Cyber-attacks are an increasingly sophisticated and an evolving danger to your sensitive data, as attackers employ new methods powered by social engineering and artificial intelligence to circumvent traditional security controls.

Cybersecurity is important because it protects all categories of data from theft and damage, including sensitive data, personally identifiable information (PII), protected health information (PHI), personal information, intellectual property, data, and governmental and industry information systems.

Without a cybersecurity program, your organization cannot defend itself against data breach campaigns, thus making it an irresistible target. Firewalls and antivirus software being your sole security measures are no longer useful. Cyber threats can come from any level of your organization. You must educate your staff about simple social engineering scams like phishing and more sophisticated cybersecurity attacks like ransomware attacks (think WannaCry) or other malware designed to steal intellectual property or personal data.

Cybercrime is Expensive and Fast Growing

Information theft is the most expensive and fastest growing segment of cybercrime, largely driven by the increasing exposure of identity information to the web via cloud services. But it is not the only target. Industrial controls that manage power grids and other infrastructure can be disrupted or destroyed, and identity theft is not the only goal. Cyber-attacks may aim to compromise data integrity (destroy or change data) to breed distrust in an organization or government.

Social engineering remains the easiest form of cyber-attack with ransomware, phishing, and spyware being the easiest forms of entry. Third-party and fourth-party vendors who process your data and have poor cybersecurity practices are another common attack vector, making vendor risk management and third-party risk management even more important. According to the Ninth Annual Cost of Cybercrime Study from Accenture and the Ponemon Institute, the average cost of cybercrime for an organization has increased by \$1.4 million over the last year to \$13.0 million and the average number of data breaches rose by 11 percent to 145. Information risk management has never been more important.

Organized Cyber Attack

Australian and North American's world's largest meat packers were hit over Memorial Day weekend by an organized cyber-attack on its information systems, Brazil's JBS SA said in a statement. The attack caused its Australian operations to shut down on Monday. "On Sunday, May 30, JBS USA determined that it was the target of an organized cybersecurity attack, affecting some of the servers supporting its North American and Australian IT systems," it said in a statement released Monday afternoon. The attack shut down operations across several Australian states, JBS Australia Chief Executive Officer Brent Eastwood told industry news website Beefcentral on Sunday, at which time he was not able to say how long the stoppage would last. The world's largest meatpacker has operations in Canada and the United States, which on Monday marked the U.S. Memorial Day public holiday.
